Burglary/Forcible/Unlawful Entry

About This Crime: Unknown offender uses opportunity to get into the homes of his victims. He generally makes entry into the homes of his victims by opening unlocked windows or doors. On occasion he has been known to break out the small glass panes of doors to gain entry. Once inside, he gathers items that he can easily carry out. Offender exits the residence the same way he entered.

What You Can Do: Lock all of your doors and windows before retiring for the evening. Notify your neighbors of the break-ins so they can secure their residences. The unknown offender generally strikes during the late evening, early morning hours when his victims are sleeping.

Offender Information: He has been seen by some of the victims who were awoken during the burglary. He is described as a male, black, 6'3", unk weight, black hair, light complexion wearing dark clothing. No further description available at this time.
